

### **AS WRITERS...**

We will be studying the book 'The Children of the Benin Kingdom' which follows the story of Ada, who discovers her true identity and must travel into the heart of the rainforest to heal the divisions that are occurring within the kingdom. Through the sequence of learning, children will explore the story from various perspectives, comparing characters and writing letters and diary entries in role. They will offer advice taken from warnings given and discover the meanings of new words within the context of the story. Throughout, children will be gathering information and building the skills towards writing a non-chronological report on the Kingdom of Benin.

### **AS MATHEMATICIANS...**

We will be using all of our knowledge in mastering activities, both mental and written. We will work on mastering fractions using our previous knowledge to help us. A continuous thread for both year groups will be applying their knowledge, especially times tables, to reasoning problems.

### **AS LINGUISTS....**

We will be learning all about the planets whilst creating aliens to send as a game to our partner school.
